Dear Camp Families,

We are praying that you have had a great school year so far and a wonderful start to 2017. Camp is right around the corner. Again this year we will be offering 9 weeks of summer camp fun. Please take time to read through this letter, including the back page for general camp information. **You will find a duplicate copy of this letter and registration form that you can give to a friend.** Please turn in your registration early so you can be assured a spot.

General Camp Information

Weekly Events: Every Wednesday at camp is "Water Day." Your camper(s) can either bring or wear their swimsuits to camp so that they can enjoy the water activity. Water day activities include water slides, slip 'n' slides and much more! We also suggest that your camper(s) bring a towel marked with their name. We will have sunscreen available, but please apply sunscreen on your camper(s) before they come to camp. Campers are also allowed to bring water guns, but we ask that the water guns are EMPTY when they come to camp. Campers will be able to fill up their water guns at camp.

Each week during summer camp we have a special day in which your child can participate. These days include crazy hair day, crazy hat day, dress-up day (pirate day, cowboy day, superhero day), etc.

Fridays are Drive-in Movie Day (usually for the lower grades). Older kids have the option to participate in a dodge ball tournament.

We also celebrate birthdays! If your child has a birthday during camp, please let a counselor know and we will be sure to sing to your camper to wish them a happy birthday!

Lunches: Campers may bring their own lunch in a small cooler or sack. Lunches will be refrigerated. All lunches should be clearly labeled with the camper's first name, last name and grade. Alternatively, lunch may be purchased from Subway. Order forms for Subway lunches will be provided before camp starts and will be due by each Wednesday of the preceding week. Lunch fees are paid directly to Subway and all lunch questions will be directed to Subway.

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Before Care & After Care: Before care is available from 7:30am to 8:30am for \$2/day per child. After care begins at 3:20pm and lasts until 5:15pm. Campers **must** be picked up by 5:15pm. The cost for after care is \$4/day per child. Before and after care is located in the Christian Life Center.

Snack & Snack Bar: A morning snack is provided for free. This snack usually consists of crackers, pretzels, or Cheez-Its and either water or lemonade.

In the afternoon we have a snack bar where campers can purchase items such as juice boxes, fruit snacks, assorted candies, and soda. Most items are \$0.50. Please note that \$1.00 is enough to get a camper a drink and treat. If you do not want your child to purchase snack bar items, please do not allow them to bring money to camp. Please do not give your child too much money that they could possibly lose or overspend. If your camper is restricted as to what they can purchase, please inform the camper's counselor.

Bringing Valuable Items: Camp is a fun and exciting experience. In this environment items tend to become misplaced or switch hands. In light of this, we request that the following or any similar possessions be left at home: toys, electronic devices, iPods, iPads, cell phones, gaming devices, trading cards, etc.

Lost & Found: In order to easily keep track of your camper's items, we ask that all items are clearly marked with your child's first and last name as well as their fall 2017 grade. Items to be marked include towels, lunchboxes, backpacks, water bottles, extra clothes, etc.

Early Pick-up: If your child needs to be picked-up early, we request that you let your child's counselor know what time they are to be picked-up during sign-in. To pick up your camper, please come to the front office. If your child is being picked-up by someone other than their parents or legal guardian; please request a release form that can be provided at the time of sign-in. Please fill out a release form prior to the day that your child will be picked-up if they are going home with a friend.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up: Campers can be dropped off as early as 8:30am. Sign-in is located at the front of the church. If your child is dropped off before 8:30am, they will need to go to before care which costs \$2/day per child. Pick-up begins at 3pm. For drive through pick-up, you will be provided with a sign with the name and grade of your camper(s) to put in the front window of your car. Campers will remain inside the church out of the heat until their names are called, at which point they will come out to your car. Parents may also park and come into the church to pick up child(ren). If your child is not picked up by 3:20pm they will go to after care which costs \$4/day per child.

Registration Due Dates: Registration fees are due by the Friday of the preceding week of camp. E.G.: fees for the second week of camp, Jun. 5-9, are due on Friday, Jun. 2. Payments will be accepted in the form of cash or checks only.

Refunds: Refunds will only be issued if notice of cancellation is received by the Friday of the preceding week. E.G.: fees paid for the 2nd week of camp, Jun. 5-9, will only be refunded if notice of cancellation is received by Jun. 2.

Rollover/Credit of Funds: Paid registration fees will not be rolled over to future weeks of camp. For example, if your child is registered for 5 days of one week, but only attends for 4 days, a credit will not be issued to a future balance. If you know in advance that your child will not attend all 5 days of any week then you may opt to register your child on a daily basis for \$30/day. The daily rate of \$30/day applies even if you register before May 1.
